

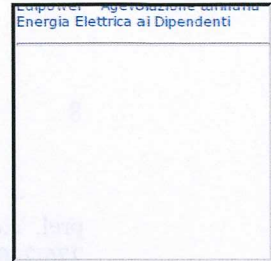

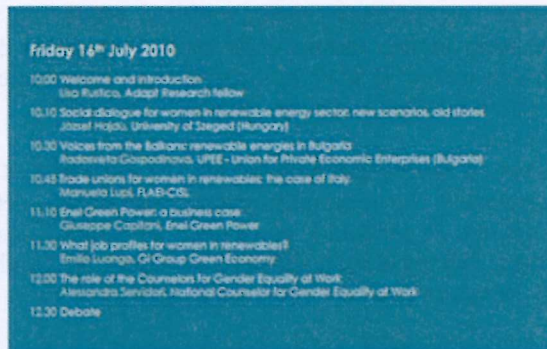

The event will focus on the role of social dialogue in renewable energy, as an instrument to increase female employment rates and support women working conditions within the sector.
