DEFINITION

“ Reaching beyond or **transcending** national **boundaries**/extending or **operating across** national boundaries/ **relating to** or involving several **nations** or nationalities”

Transnational:

- ✓ not only movements across borders
 - ✓ sovereignty dimension
 - ✓ legally autonomous entity

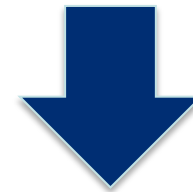
