Purpose and lawfulness of processing, data category and storage period.

In order to comply with EU and national legislation (EU Regulation 679/2016, hereafter: the Regulation), we inform you that your personal data will be used by a team led by Federmeccanica and made up of ADAPT, FUNDAE and GZS. Data will be used for the following purposes, in the context of the project: "Social Dialogue for the future of Manufacturing" (SoDiMa).

Purposes for which data will be processed:

To fill out an online questionnaire (a semi-structured questionnaire available on the Google Moduli platform)

Legal basis for the processing: consent from the data subject (art. 6, par. 1, let. a) of the Regulation) Category of the personal data processed: identification data

Storage period: up to 36 months or for the time needed to carry out the SoDiMa project.

Nature of data

Providing data is optional. Failing to supply or refusing to answer questions makes it impossible to take part in the questionnaire.

Processing Modalities

The processing of the data for the purposes illustrated above (i.e. the questionnaire) can take place manually, by means of electronic devices, through paper or digital format. Data are stored on digital devices.

User Categories

For the purposes referred to before, data could be communicated to: -ADAPT -FUNDAE -GZS

Specifically, data can be communicated to other institutions that participate in the project, such as the European Commission. This can also take place anonymously, should the European Commission process data for institutional proceedings.

Storage Period

Data will be stored until the end of the SoDiMa project (January 2021). After that date, data will be deleted or rendered anonymous.

Data Subjects' Rights

As a data subject, you can at any time ask the data processor:

- for confirmation about the existence of data concerning him/her;

- to have access to his/her data and information; to rectify or to amend incomplete or erroneous data; to erase personal data (if one of the conditions pointed out in par. 1, Article 17 of the Regulation arises, and considering the exceptions laid down in par. 3 of the same Article); to restrict processing should one of the conditions set forth in par. 1, Article 18 of the Regulation arises; to anonymize data and to stop using them if employed illegally. This also applies to data for which storage is not required considering the purposes for which they have been collected and then processed.

Data subjects also have the right to oppose, fully or in part:
